

Terms & Conditions – MRO Quest 2026

1. General Overview

- MRO Quest 2026 is an online scholarship assessment conducted by Manav Rachna Online for admission into select Undergraduate (UG) and Postgraduate (PG) programs for the July 2026 intake.
- Participation in the test implies acceptance of all terms and conditions stated herein.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- The scholarship test is open to:
 - Students who have completed or are appearing for their qualifying examinations (10+2 for UG / Graduation for PG).
 - Working professionals, homemakers, and other eligible learners as per program-specific requirements.
- Final admission is subject to fulfillment of **program-specific eligibility criteria**, document verification, and approval by the university.

3. Registration & Participation

- Candidates must register through the official website only.
- The university reserves the right to:
 - Accept or reject any application without assigning a reason.
 - Modify or cancel the test schedule in case of unforeseen circumstances.
- Candidates are responsible for providing accurate and complete information during registration.

4. Exam Format & Conduct

- The test will be conducted online in an **AI-proctored environment**.
- Duration: 60 minutes
- Total Questions: 90 MCQs
- Sections include:
 - Aptitude & General Awareness
 - Arithmetic & Logical Reasoning
 - English Comprehension

- The exam is aptitude-based and aligned broadly with Class 12 level difficulty.
- There is **no negative marking**.
- The responses submitted by candidates during the MRO Quest 2026 examination shall be treated as confidential and will not be disclosed, shared, or made accessible to applicants under any circumstances.

5. Proctoring & Fair Usage Policy

- The exam will be monitored using AI tools via webcam and microphone.
- Any of the following may lead to **disqualification**:
 - Use of unfair means or external assistance
 - Multiple faces detected or suspicious movement
 - Switching tabs, devices, or browsers
 - Tampering with camera/microphone
- The university's decision regarding misconduct will be **final and binding**.

6. Technical Requirements

- Candidates must ensure:
 - A functional laptop/desktop (mobile devices may not be supported)
 - Stable internet connection
 - Working webcam and microphone
 - Quiet, well-lit environment
- The university will **not be responsible** for:
 - Connectivity issues
 - Device malfunctions
 - Power failures during the test

7. Scholarship Criteria & Award

Scholarships are awarded based on performance in the test:

- **≥ 90%: Up to 100% tuition fee waiver***
- **80%–89%: Up to 50% tuition fee waiver***
- **60%–79%: Up to 30% tuition fee waiver***

Important Guidelines:

- Scholarship is applicable **only on tuition fees** and does not cover:
 - Registration fees
 - Examination fees

- Other administrative or external charges
- Scholarships are **limited, competitive, and subject to availability**.
- Score 90% or above and rank among the **top 20 candidates** to become eligible for a **100% waiver** on tuition fees, awarded on a **first-come, first-served basis** as per the final merit list released by the institution.
- Score 80–89% and rank among the **top 75 candidates** to become eligible for a **50% waiver** on tuition fees, awarded on a **first-come, first-served basis** as per the final merit list.
- Score 60–79% and rank among the **top 100 candidates** to become eligible for a **30% waiver** on tuition fees, awarded on a **first-come, first-served basis** as per the final merit list.
- All eligible students will be moved to the **waiting list** if they do not fall within the number of seats available in each category.
- Students will be **automatically considered for the next eligible category** if seats in their qualified category are full.
- **This scholarship will NOT be clubbed with any other scholarship or offer.**

8. Validity of Scholarship

- The scholarship/offer granted shall be **valid for a period of one month from the date of result announcement**.
- The offer is **non-transferable and non-deferrable**.
- Candidates must complete admission formalities within the specified timeline to avail the scholarship.

9. Admission Policy

- Qualifying the scholarship test does **not guarantee admission**.
- Admission is subject to:
 - Meeting academic eligibility
 - Submission of valid documents
 - Payment of applicable fees within deadlines
- The university reserves the right to cancel admission if any discrepancy is found.

10. Results & Communication

- Results will be declared on 26th May 2026 at 6pm, on the following link.

- The university's evaluation and result declaration will be **final and non-contestable**.

- Mock tests are provided for practice purposes only.
- Performance in mock tests has **no impact** on final scholarship evaluation.

- The university reserves the right to:
 - Modify test pattern, schedule, or scholarship criteria
 - Cancel or reschedule the exam due to technical or administrative reasons
- Any updates will be communicated via official channels.

 - Collection and processing of personal data for admission and evaluation purposes
 - AI-based monitoring during the exam
- Data will be handled as per applicable privacy laws and university policies.
